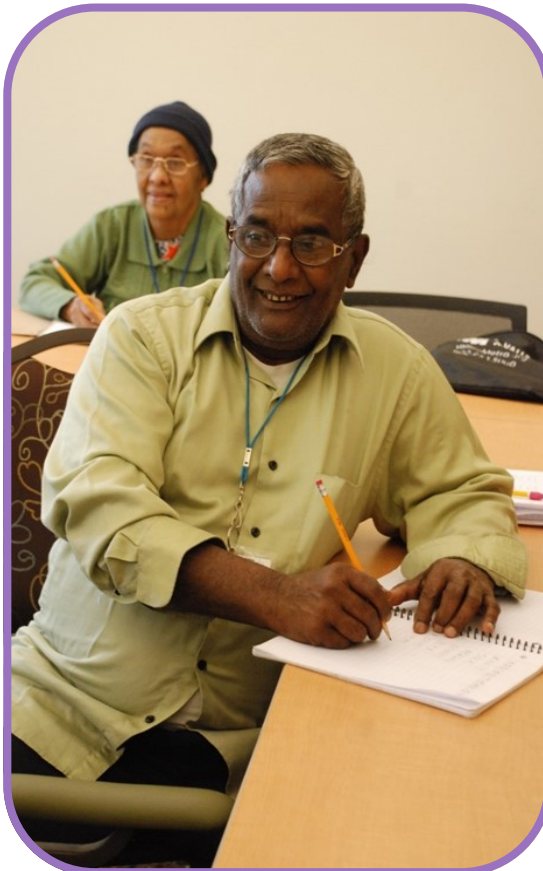

## TEACH

a Preliterate English, or Citizenship Class

- Teach basic, survival English to a class of 10-15 elderly refugees who are “preliterate” (not literate in their native language). Many have never attended school before.
- Work with students from over 16 different countries including Burma, Bhutan, Cuba, Burundi, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, and Iraq.
- Commit to teach a 10-week class session (2 hour classes, 2 days per week, for 10 weeks).
- Attend a curriculum training session and observe 2 class sessions before volunteering
- Curriculum, and lesson plans are provided, no previous teaching experience necessary

## ASSIST

with a Preliterate or Citizenship Class

- Help the primary class teacher to implement lesson plans
- Work with groups of 5-7 elderly refugees to complete classroom exercises

## TUTOR

one-on-one in English or civics

- help individual elderly refugees prepare for their citizenship test
- Assist struggling students with additional English tutoring

All volunteer positions require an AZ DPS Level One Fingerprint Clearance Card
