### Authority to Arrest:

An "authority to arrest form" gives the police department permission to patrol your property and arrest people trespassing on your property when the business is closed. During business hours, an officer will make contact with the business owner/agent to verify that the person is not a customer or otherwise allowed to be on the property.

Forms can be filled out online at <https://www.phoenix.gov/police/neighborhood-resources/criminal-trespass> or by contacting the Desert Horizon Precinct at (602) 495-5006. Authority to arrest forms **must** be completed by the property owner/agent and must contain their original signature. This form needs to be updated every year. Thirty days before the expiration, owners/agents will receive a reminder of expiration via the registered/primary e-mail address on file that the Authority to Arrest form will need to be completed again and submitted to remain valid.

No trespassing signs must also be posted on the property. These can be purchased from various sign companies. Please let us know if you have an authority to arrest form on file, or if we can help you obtain one.

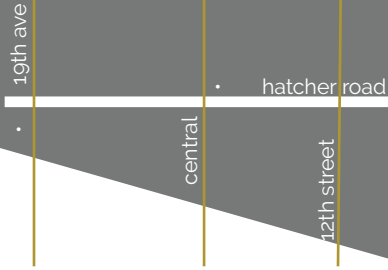
